From the window of the bus you may see the building of “Stalin’s Empire” style- the KGB, the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the largest department store GUM. The KGB building on Independence Avenue was recognized as the best architectural construction in the USSR.</p> <p>You will take a walk along the Upper Town. There will be an opportunity to take a photo of the beautiful panorama of the city from the observation deck, to see the Cathedral of Holy Spirit, the Town Hall. On Victory Square you will have a chance to see one of the most grandiose and majestic architectural ensembles in Minsk and to make a walk along the streets of Trinity Suburb.</p> <p>Visit October Street, where the old warehouses turned into a quarter of street art. «Dukorsky Maentak» is a unique combination of a tourist centre and a restored old manor with a centuries-old history. This amazing place offers many opportunities for everyone, who wants to complement the comfortable modern holiday with immersion into the gentry past of our ancestors. Excursion programmes give a chance to get into the atmosphere of a gentry manor.

Excursion to the stable of the complex with the ability to pat and feed the horses;

- Visiting 400-year-old oak;
- Visiting the zoo (ostriches, goats, chickens, geese, musk ducks, etc.);
- Visit to the acting pottery workshop;
- Visit to the working workshop for making candles made from natural wax;
- Historical attraction "Battle horn" with a story and display of various types of ancient signal and battle horns, and also it is possible to blow your own horn;

- Historical attraction "Shlyakhetskaya Pelyavanne" (throwing darts at the target in the form of a running deer) with awarding prizes to the winners;
- Visiting an inverted house,
- Horseback riding in a britzka.

MIR CASTLE (www.mirzamak.by) was built in the XVI century. Its bright architectural look, mighty walls and towers, colorful courtyard leave a lasting impression which will be complemented by the MUSEUM EXPOSITION inside the castle. You will feel the atmosphere of life in the castle passing through the basements where provision was kept and the Ball-room swimming in luxury of Rococo style... Alongside the castle there is the flamboyant chapel of the Svyatopolk-Mirsky family. The historic part of the town of MIR - the place where Belarusians, Poles, Jews, Gipsies and Tartars had been living together for a long time - kept the atmosphere of the former small town... The ensemble of the market place is formed by the Orthodox and Catholic Churches, synagogues, Yeshiva, the houses of craftsmen and merchants.
